The Troubadour Theater Company is celebrating its twelfth year of laughs. Los Angeles' renowned ensemble of actors, comedians and musicians has performed throughout southern California since 1995. Their fast-paced, laugh-filled "adaptations" of classic plays, as well as their original works and hilarious sketch material, make Troubadour a unique and exciting experience for theater-goers of any age. Past productions at the Falcon Theatre include: *A Charlie James Brown Christmas*, *JACKSON FROST*; *Much Adoobie Brothers About Nothing*; *Little Drummer Bowie*; *Hamlet, the Artist Formerly Known as Prince of Denmark*; *Santa Claus is Comin' to Motown*; *It's a Stevie Wonderful Life*; *OthE.L.O.*, *Alice in One-Hit-Wonderland* and *As U2 Like It..* In addition to the Falcon, Troubadour has performed at Hollywood's Ford Amphitheatre and Matrix Theatre, Santa Monica's Miles Playhouse, the Ojai Shakespeare Festival, the San Francisco Fringe Festival, the Adelaide Fringe Festival (Australia) and in Hailey, Idaho, in conjunction with Company of Fools at the Liberty Theatre.

Matt Walker (Director) Matt Walker has worked as a professional in theater, film, television, opera, theme park and circus. As artistic director of The Troubadour Theater Company since 1995, he has directed shows including: *Twelfth Dog Night*, *Alice In-One-Hit-Wonderland*, and *Much A Doobie Brothers About Nothing* (LADCC Awards), and received the 2006 OC Weekly Theater Award for Career Achievement, and the 2007 LADCC Award for Sustained Excellence in Theater. Walker has trained with notable performers and organizations, including: Bill Irwin, Denis LeCombe (Cirque du Soleil), Rachel Rosenthal, Second City, The Royal Shakespeare Co., and The San Francisco Mime Troupe. Walker is also a graduate of Ringling Bros. Clown College, and has performed with The Greatest Show on Earth. From 2003-2006, Walker was adjunct professor of Clowning and Commedia at the University of California at San Diego, MFA Acting. Most recently he has written and directed a show for Universal Studios/Orlando, featuring Christopher Walken and Dwayne Johnson, served as associate director to Garry Marshall on *Happy Days the Musical*, and directed the world premiere production of *Million Dollar Quartet* at The Seaside Music Theater in Daytona, FL. For television, he has directed numerous shows including: *Dinner & A Movie* (TBS), *Dude Room* (Discovery), and *Saturday Night Solution* (Court TV). Future projects include original productions for Cal Rep, USC, and The Getty Villa.

The Falcon Theatre is a 130-seat performing arts space located in the Burbank, California media district. Built by Director/Writer/Producer Garry Marshall and his daughter Kathleen Marshall, the Falcon offers a 5-play subscription series from August through April, in addition to family shows in the summer. The Falcon Theatre is located at 4252 Riverside Drive in Burbank, California.
