English actor **Jonathan Cake** has performed with the Royal Shakespeare Company and made his Broadway debut in 2002 in *Medea*; his television credits include *Chuck*, *Six Degrees* and *Desperate Housewives*. **Stephen Spinella** is a two-time Tony Award-winning actor for his performance as ‘Prior Walter’ in the original Broadway productions of *Angels in America: Millennium Approaches* and *Angels in America: Perestroika*; he was nominated for a Tony Award for Best Featured Actor in a Musical for *James Joyce’s The Dead* and his screen work includes the television series *Desperate Housewives* and the film *Milk*. **Graham Hamilton** has appeared on many Southern California stages, such as South Coast Rep, Antaeus Theatre Company, Broad Stage, The Old Globe and most recently at A Noise Within in *The Illusion*; his television work includes *Touch*, *Guiding Light* and *Ugly Betty*. **Lesli Margherita** is a recipient of the Laurence Olivier Award for her performance in *Zorro the Musical* and most recently won the 2011 Ovation Award for Best Actress in a Musical for *Kiss Me Kate* at Reprise!. She recently starred in *Little Shop of Horrors* at La Mirada Theatre and has appeared in numerous television shows such as *Fame LA* and *On the Lot*.

*The Grönholm Method* premieres at the Falcon Theatre on August 17, with previews beginning August 7, as the first show of its 2012-2013 subscription season.
